Workforce: TAPSA volunteers, Hospital Intern Pharmacists and Full-time Community Pharmacist

#### **Activities**

- i. Distribution of brochures, 3,000 pcs each day in total
- ii. Communicate intended message on selected topics to at least 3,000 people each day
- iii. Administer questionnaires, on the selected topic (e.g Health insurance for all/Bima ya Afya kwa wote), to target group, at least 3,000 per day in total [25 people per volunteer per day](3 days will be for health for all/bima ya afya kwa wote (UHI) and 1 day for antimicrobial resistance (AMR)
- iv. **MoH and PORALG** led regional pharmacists, districts pharmacists and facilities pharmacists in-charge meeting
